Sitting Bull was a great Indian chief for the Standing Rock Sioux tribe and led them into many victorious battles including the Battle of Little Bighorn and the Red Cloud's War, he was also in Buffalo Bill's Wild West Show. Sadly he was captured and then later killed by the Indian Police.
